The reward fund for the David Grubbs homicide investigation is now at \$10,000. Donations are still being accepted. The reward will be given to any person who provides information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of David Michael Grubbs.

There is also a \$1,000 reward offered through Southern Oregon Crime Stoppers.
