



City of Ashland Election Signage

The Ashland Municipal Code (AMC) regulations for the size, placement and timing of election signs are summarized below.

2026 Political Sign Display dates:

May 19, 2026, Primary Election

Post: April 4, 2026

Remove: May 26, 2026

November 3, 2026, General Election

Post: September 19, 2026

Remove: November 10, 2026

Summary:

- Election signs can be located on private property
- Election signs cannot be placed:
 - in the public right of way or on public property
 - in the parkrow in front of a house
 - in a median which is in the street Right of Way
 - on City property including parks

18.4.7.040 Exempted Signs

The following signs and devices shall not be subject to the provisions of this chapter. All of the following exempted signs shall be subject to the other regulations contained in chapter 18.4.7 relative to the size, lighting, or spacing of such signs.

AMC 18.4.7.040 (K)

- Temporary Signs, Elections. Temporary, non-illuminated signs not exceeding four square feet, provided the signs are erected no more than 45 days prior to and removed within seven days following an election.

AMC 18.4.7.030 (B) Placement of Signs

1. Near Residential. No sign shall be located in a commercial or industrial zone so that it is primarily visible only from a residential zone.
2. Near Street Intersections. No signs in excess of 2 ½ feet in height shall be placed in the vision clearance area pursuant to the vision clearance area requirements in section 18.2.4.040.
3. Near Driveways. No sign or portion of thereof shall be erected within ten feet of driveways unless the same is less than 2 ½ feet in height pursuant to the vision clearance area requirements in section 18.2.4.040.
