

Toilet Rebate Program Eligibility & Instructions

Eligibility

- Be a city of Ashland water utility customer.
- **Install a WaterSense labeled 1.28-gallon-per-flush toilet in your home, rental, or business.**
- Be willing to have an inspection of the installation and a water use evaluation done on the house.

Instructions

- **Purchase a WaterSense-labeled toilet.** Eligible models are identified with a WaterSense label. Verify by reviewing the list of qualifying toilets on the EPA website:
<http://www.epa.gov/watersense/residential-toilets>
- **Inspection & Water Use Evaluation.** Once you have installed your new toilet, you need to call or email the conservation division for an inspection.
- **Application and Receipt.** You can fill out an application on our website or request an application in person. You may then either submit a copy of the invoice with the application online or have it ready for conservation staff upon the inspection's arrival.
